


## Outdoor Activities

**Local Short Hikes:** If you want to get out and walk a mile or so, here are three options:


1. Ike Kinswa State Park: Short hike along the point jutting out into the lake is a relaxing trek. There is a walking path which is maintained. Discovery Pass is required to be in any Washington State Park now, which is \$7 per day. Bummer about the fee.

2. Other side of the lake is Mayfield County Park (no fees). It is another simple 30-40 minute hike alongside the lake and then looping around on the park grounds.


To get to the park, drive back to State Highway 12, turn left (east), go across bridge and about 0.5 miles from the bridge, turn left on Beach Road. Follow the road to the boat launch/picnic area.

3. Another 20 minute (up the hill) hike is a nice lookout. If you look across the lake, there is a cross on the hill. The trail leading up to the cross is a series of short switchbacks which isn't too hard. The view on top is worth the short uphill trip.

## Outdoor Activities

When you turn right on to Birley Road (by deGoede's), you will immediately turn left (east) on Mossyrock Road. About 200 yards up the road is a small road called DeGoede Drive heading to the left. Take it and go under the highway, follow the drive to the right as shown in the diagram below and drive back to the small Catholic Church parking lot. After the hike, you might want to stop in deGoede's for some flower bulbs or other local goods.
